

# Download Kubinka, The Russian Museum Of Armoured Vehicles

The SU-14 was a prototype Soviet heavy self-propelled gun built on a T-35 chassis. The original prototype mounted a 203 mm howitzer M1931 (B-4); the SU-14-1 variant of 1936 carried a 152 mm gun M1935 (Br-2) which could fire 48.9 kilogram shells at ranges up to 25 km. Its armour was 20 to 50 mm thick. It never entered serial production. Work on the vehicle began in 1933, with a prototype built ...T-26 mod. 1933 at the museum "Breaching of the Leningrad Blockade" near Kirovsk, Leningrad Oblast. This tank was raised from a river bottom at Nevsky Pyatachok in May 2003. The great brother of the Dingo, the Daimler Armoured Car was given the Mark VII light tank 2-pdr turret for armed reconnaissance, mass-built until 1945. The Austin-Putilov was a Russian built armored car based on the Austin series III chassis and was used during the Civil War.
