The white-tailed deer (*Odocoileus virginianus*), also known as the whitetail or Virginia deer, is a medium-sized deer native to the United States, Canada, Mexico, Central America, and South America as far south as Peru and Bolivia. It has also been introduced to New Zealand, Cuba, Jamaica, Hispaniola, Puerto Rico, the Bahamas, the Lesser Antilles, and some countries in Europe, such as Finland ...Deer are members of the order Artiodactyle, which means that they have hoofs with an even number of toes. Deer can be found around the world. Hunters in the field often salt a hide. About 20 pounds of salt is recommended for a black bear hide, and 40 pounds for a brown bear.
