Hyperplastic polyps (HPs) are asymptomatic and have no malignant potential. They are the most common colonic polyp (75 - 90% of colon polyps), typically 1 - 5 mm in greatest dimension, rarely 1 cm or greater. A bruise is generally understood to mean an area of haemorrhage caused by the leakage of blood from ruptured vessels (including capillaries, but predominantly veins, venules and small arterioles) - into surrounding (perivascular) tissues, following a 'blow'. Simple epithelium has only one cell layer where every cell is in direct contact with the underlying basement membrane.
